A form of residential shared living in which third party service providers rent living spaces that allow three or more biologically unrelated residents to live communally and conveniently while sharing space and resources.

Conscious Coliving How To: Enhance wellbeing in your Community

- Is coliving a cure for loneliness?
- Is the architecture in our cities enhancing our wellbeing or causing physical and mental ill health?
- How can our citymakers and architects design for wellbeing and social interaction?
- Are coliving spaces currently designed to optimise these essential factors of human evolution?

Researchers are observing that loneliness and social isolation are as bad to our health as <u>smoking a pack of cigarettes a day</u>. These are absurd findings and the answers seem to be right in front of us: according to the <u>Happiness Research Institute</u> the quality of our relationships is one of the best indicators of whether people are happy or not. But if people of all generations are feeling so disconnected (findings show that <u>millenials are the most lonely generation</u>), what can we do as a society to prevent and heal this? One thing is true is that our current built environment is not equipped to support global population growth and these disturbances in health. As coliving developers, operators and architects, there is a responsibility to design the next generation of homes with all of these factors in mind.

The resources below explore how we can design for wellbeing, happiness and human flourishing. They also share how we can measure individual and collective wellbeing in order to understand whether our coliving communities are thriving or not. At Conscious Coliving, one our aims is to reduce the human cost of poor housing and to create spaces that foster physiological safety and wellbeing. We are in 2020 and the consensus of global climate scientists and researchers is that we have 10 years to drastically shift the way we consume and live in our daily lives. The built environment is the one of the sectors that has the highest carbon emissions in the world (the built environment contributes to <u>40% of</u> <u>total carbon emissions</u> in the U.K. alone). This said, as coliving developers and operators, we have a huge responsibility to contribute positively to social, economic and environmental sustainability. This is not an easy task and **requires the coliving sector to go above and beyond** real estate standards to prove that coliving is genuinely a sustainable housing alternative.

The following resources are best practices when it comes to embedding sustainability into the core of any business in order to respond to global frameworks and requirements for achieving net zero. As coliving is an offer with the HUMAN at the core, it's time to embody this and as coliving brands help foster connection at the individual, collective and ecological level.


The result is a report which summarises their findings and provides an outlook on where the sector might be headed. It also includes profiles on each operator with their backgrounds, operating models and market positioning.




